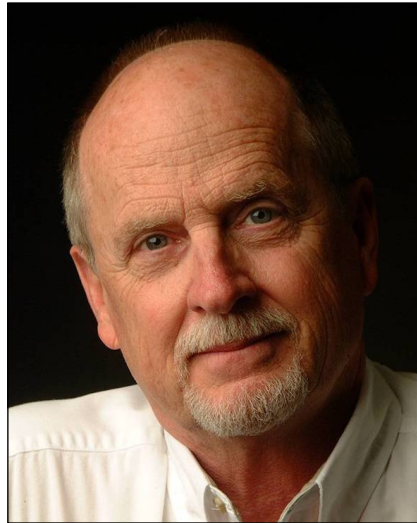

The bestselling author of *Stranger at the Gate: To be Gay and Christian in America* provides an insider's exposé of the Christian Right's agenda—and a playbook in how to resist it nonviolently.

The Reverend Dr. Mel White sees fundamentalism as “Evangelical orthodoxy gone cultic.” He believes that the true goals of today's Christian fundamentalists are to break down the wall that separates church and state, superimpose their “moral values” on the U.S. Constitution, replace democracy with theocratic rule, and ultimately create a new “Christian America” in their image. White's new book, *Religion Gone Bad*, is a wake-up call to all of us to take heed.

White is singularly qualified to write this exposé of the Christian Right because he served the evangelical movement as pastor, professor, filmmaker, television producer, author, and ghostwriter for such fundamentalist leaders as Pat Robertson, Jerry Falwell, and Billy Graham. White is also a gay man, who made news when he came out more than twelve years ago with his bestselling autobiography: *Stranger at the Gate: To be Gay and Christian in America*.
